## Mission Statement

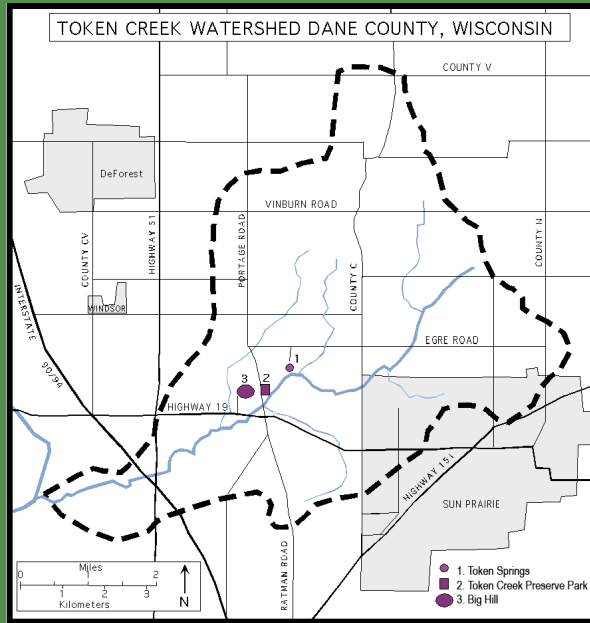

The Token Creek drains a 27 square mile watershed in north-central Dane County, Wisconsin. It is a locally and regionally important water resource because the watershed is:

- fed by the largest natural springs in southern Wisconsin
- the largest source of water for Lake Mendota
- a unique natural island in a rapidly developing suburban landscape
